### Slaughterhouse Five Woodwind Quintet

Slaughterhouse Five Woodwind Quintet has been playing together for over 20 years, with remarkably little change in personnel. We have performed many concerts together and have been able to explore a wide variety of the literature for woodwind quintet and larger woodwind ensembles, including several world premieres. Our members are all involved in other professional capacities than music performance, which makes our longevity and dedication to quality all the more remarkable.

Pamela Fisher, flute is employed by the Indiana Economic Development Commission. She is principal flutist in the Hendricks Symphony Orchestra, and piccolo soloist with the Philharmonic Orchestra of Indianapolis, and flutist with the Slaughterhouse Five and Hendricks SO Woodwind Quintets. She received her Bachelor's and Master's degrees in music from Ball State University.

Lee Jones, oboe is principal oboist in the Bloomington Symphony and the Philharmonic Orchestra of Indianapolis. He is music director of the Athenaeum Pops Orchestra and the Phillips Music Guild of Indianapolis. He studied music at Indiana University and the Cincinnati College Conservatory of Music with Keith Kummer and Ferdinand Prior. A woodwind specialist, he volunteer teaches music in many area schools as representative of the Phillips Music Guild.

Cindy Moss, clarinet is recently retired from active teaching in Shelbyville Central Schools. She is principal clarinet of the Philharmonic Orchestra of Indianapolis and the Indianapolis Chamber Winds, and is assistant principal clarinet of the Indiana Wind Symphony. She has a BME degree from Indiana State University, and a Masters from Indiana University. She is especially proud of her 31 years in Shelbyville Schools, during which time the programs of music tripled in size and quality.

Mike Bratcher, bassoon has his own business as a piano technician all over Central Indiana. He is principal bassoon of the Philharmonic Orchestra of Indianapolis, and free-lances in orchestras all over central Indiana. He graduated in 1993 from Butler University with a degree in Arts Administration. His current interest is in Irish and Folk music played with his own group.

Andrew Van Dyke, french horn is a native of Avon, Indiana, and graduated in 2005 from Wheaton College Conservatory of Music in Wheaton, Illinois. He is currently band director at the Liberty Christian School (Anderson). He plays in the

Hendricks Symphony and free-lances throughout the area.
