This weekend is full of fun at the Strand. On Friday night there will be another chance to see some John Calvert films. We are showing Devil's Cargo and Search for Danger. The double feature starts at 7:00pm and is only \$4. Mr. Calvert will be at the Strand on October 16th, so this is a great opportunity to see his films.

On Saturday night we are showing a horror genre classic Carnival of Souls. We have a loyal following from all around central Indiana. We love meeting people from out of town who travel to the heart of Shelby County to visit the Strand. We have had great comments from many patrons who have visited our local restaurants, and as expected the obligatory stop at with our friends at Indiana Downs and Indiana Live! on the way home. We have a lot to offer, and we are pleased that the Strand is the catalyst for some. We will see you on Saturday night, the show starts at 8:00pm and is only \$5.
