Auditions for You're a Good Man Charlie Brown will take place on May 10th and 11th, 2011 from 6:30-8:30pm at the Strand Theatre, located at 215 South Harrison Street Shelbyville, Indiana.

Casting needs for the show are four men, four women, and chorus members. Actors will be asked to prepare 16 measures of music for the audition, and may bring either sheet music or an accompaniment CD. Please wear comfortable shoes and clothing and come prepared to dance. Actors will also be asked to read from the script and sing from the libretto.

You're a Good Man Charlie Brown tells the story of an average day in the life of the famous comic strip child hero, Charlie Brown. It is a day made up of little moments picked from all the days of Charlie Brown, from Valentine's Day to the baseball season, from wild optimism to utter despair, all mixed in with the lives of his friends (both human and non-human) and strung together on the string of a single day, from bright uncertain morning to hopeful starlit evening. Most of the characters are 5-6 years old; however the show is generally cast with adults.
