Miah Michaelsen is the Assistant Economic Development Director for the Arts for the City of Bloomington. As Assistant Director of Economic Development for the Arts, Michaelsen's responsibilities include leading management of BEAD (the Bloomington Entertainment and Arts District), serving as a liaison with the City's Arts Commission, working with artists and community arts organizations to promote the arts as economic development, and coordinating public arts projects along the City's B-Line Trail and in BEAD character districts. Previous to her position with the City, Michaelsen was Executive Director of the Bloomington Area Arts Council. Before relocating to Bloomington, Michaelsen held arts administrative executive positions at the Children's Hands-On Museum, the Kentuck Festival of the Arts and Theater Tuscaloosa all in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. She currently serves on the boards of Visit Bloomington and Indiana Artisan.
