1913 Flood Lecture ? April 16, 2013

The Strand Lecture Series continued on Tuesday April, 16 2013. The Shelby County Historical Society, The Shelbyville News, The City of Shelbyville and the Strand presented a lecture on the GREAT FLOOD OF 1913.

Shelby County Historian and local author Ron Hamilton was joined by City Engineer Rodger Keller, PE. Ron gave a vivid description of the hours leading up to, through, and after the flood. He retold stories of people who experienced the event a hundred years ago.



The audience was greeted by a torrential downpour for several hours before the lecture. It put everyone "in the mood." The presentation included pictures from 1913 and the same areas today. There were also maps of Shelbyville and showing the extent of the water. Alas, the Strand would have been flooded, but good for us we weren't built until 3 years later!
