Our project includes:

Removing the seats

Bagging the seat cushions and seat backs

Removing seat and row number tags

Getting the seats ready for loading

Loading, moving and unloading

There are plenty of jobs for all skill levels. If you have tools, here is the tool list needed: (tools are not necessary to volunteer)

1/2" Socket with 4" extension

3/8" Socket with 4" extension

(deep sockets will work too)

Power Screwdriver (drill) with Phillips Bit

Vise Grips

Those tools are all that is needed for the job. The seats we are removing are in the upper balcony. We will have to carry them to the lobby in preparation for loading on Wednesday night. This is a project where the more volunteers we have, the easier it will be. The ISO is being very gracious allowing us to do this work at night. This is an exciting time for the Strand. You can be a part of this adventure.

We will meet at the Strand Theatre at 5:30 pm on Tuesday July 9th and again on Wednesday July 10th. We will drive to the Hilbert Circle Theatre. Our parking will be in the lot immediately to the east of the theatre on Pennsylvania Street. The cost is \$4. We will enter thru the side alley entrance of the theatre.
