Road work in front of the Strand makes it difficult for the contractor to maintain access to the theater. They have graciously offered to keep things open for us, but we are partners as well and have opted to cancel Friday's event to help facilitate the smooth and effective renovation of our curbs and sidewalk. The sidewalk will be replaced to 18' from the front of the theater. They will maintain our marquee drains under the sidewalk that were existing. This is a complex project, and we appreciate INDOT and the contractor working with us to maintain the integrity of the Strand.

We are dark until Saturday June 2, 2018 when we welcome ERIC SOMMER to the Strand. Our community would like to grow, this is one way we can help.
